



TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATION - 2022







The main focus of the interaction was to make students understand the ways to prepare for group exams and the useful website, links and books for preparation.










DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS







DEPARTMENT OF CATERING SCIENCE AND HOTEL MANAGEMENT



DEPARTMENT OF COSTUME DESIGN AND FASHION



DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY






DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE WITH COMPUTER APPLICATIONS
