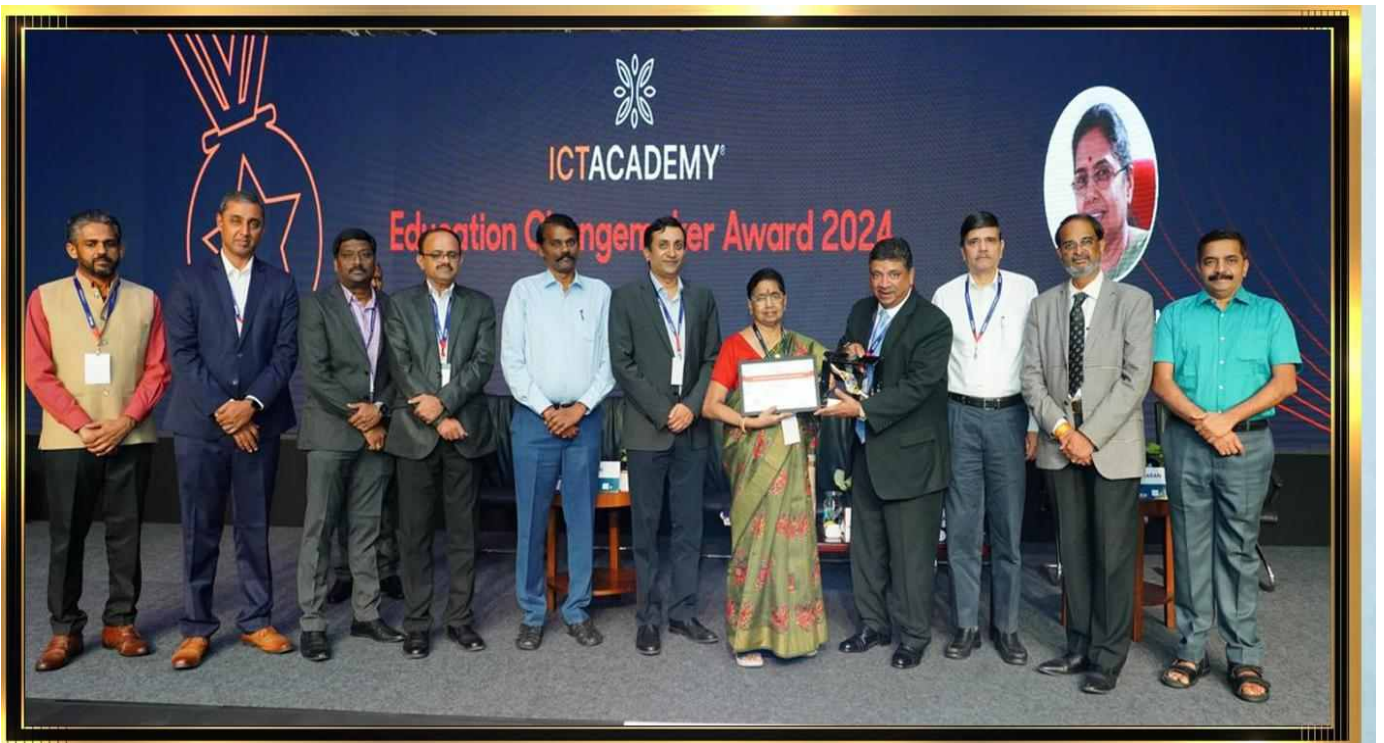

78TH INDEPENDENCE DAY



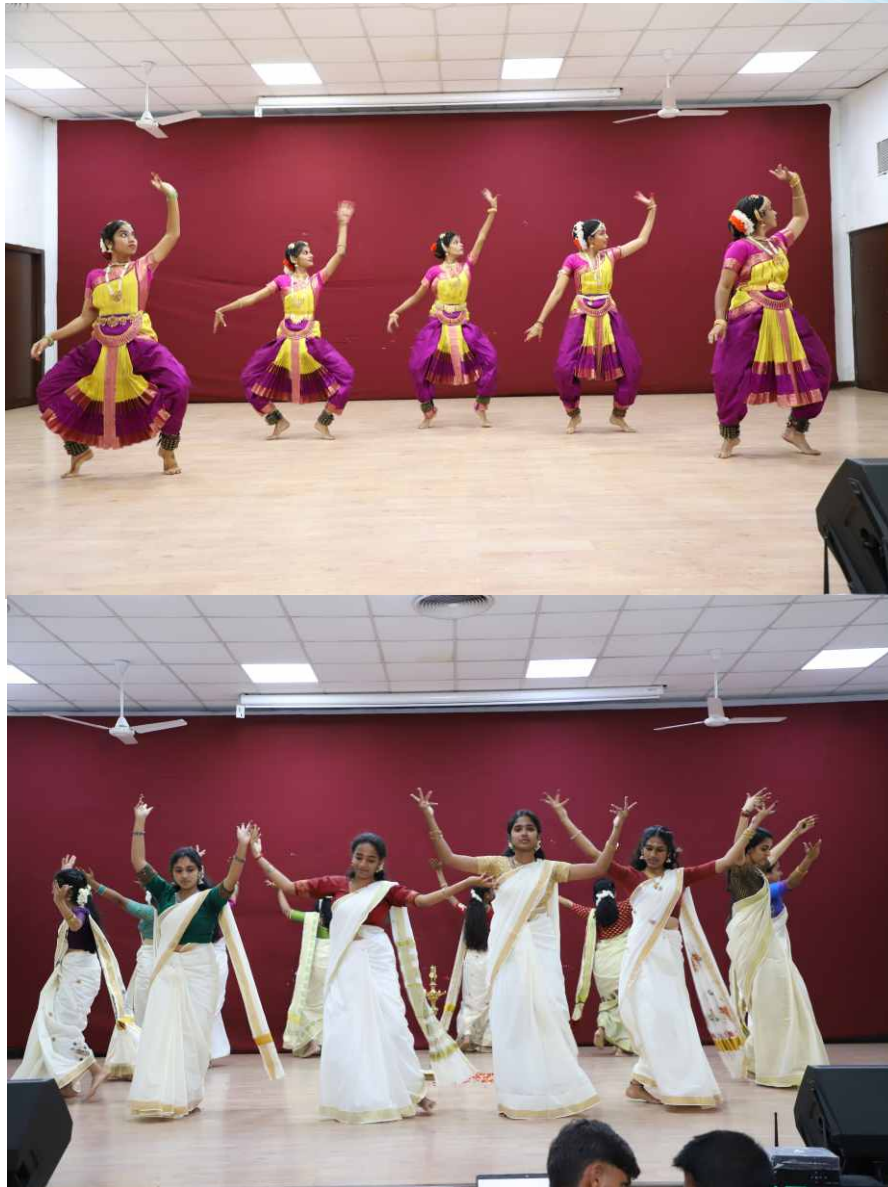

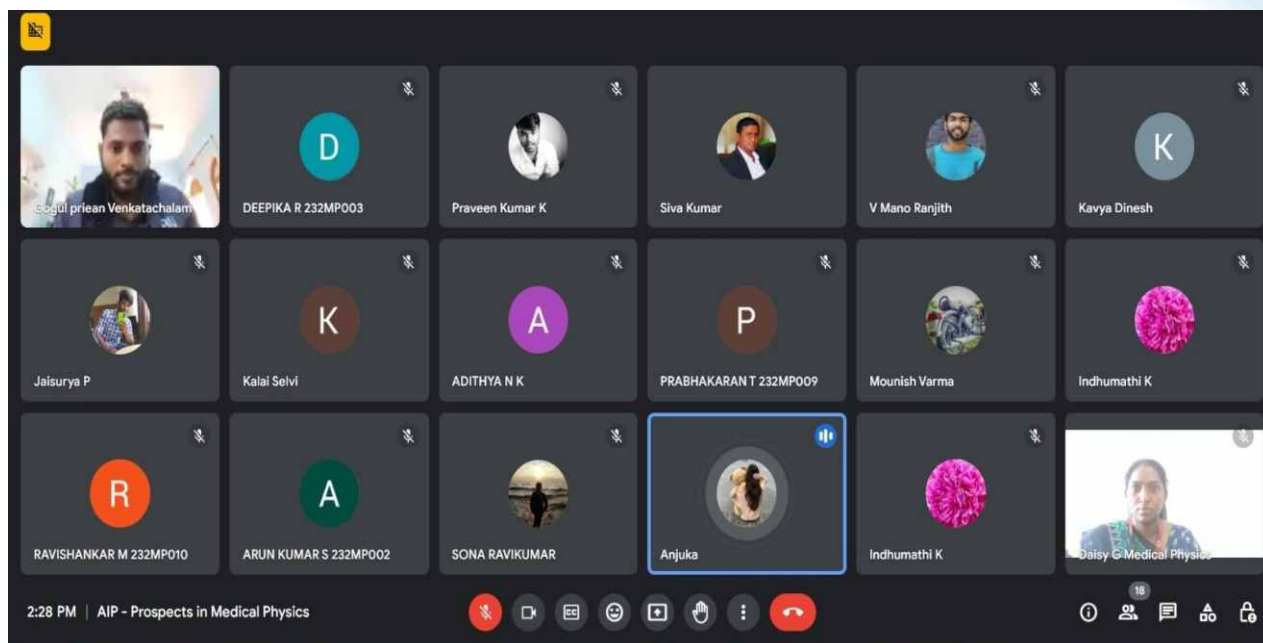

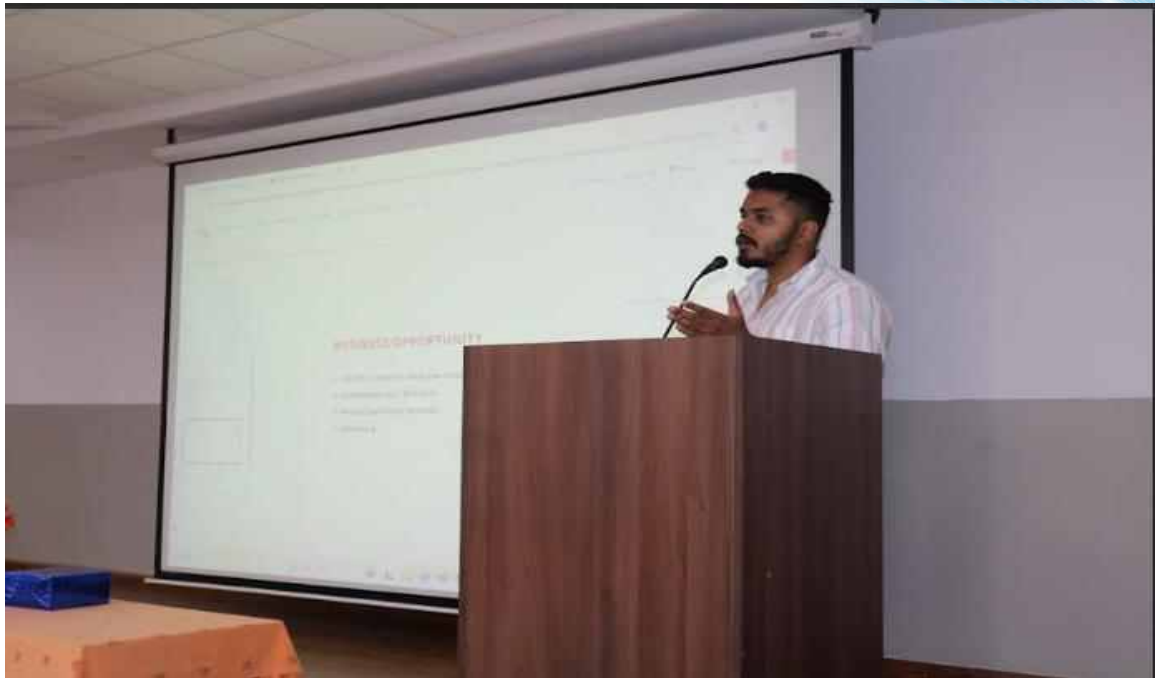
