



networking, and knowledge sharing through expert sessions, panel discussions, and exhibitions.


- Member roles were discussed to ensure smooth coordination of events and documentation.

#### **4 Resolution on the proposed Activities for the academic year 2023-24:**


- Resolved that a tentative activity calendar would be prepared in collaboration with ICT Academy and shared in the next meeting for the finalisation.
