Item 1.5: To decide on the initiatives to be undertaken by the Centre for IoT for providing internship opportunities to students

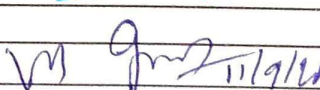

Resolution:

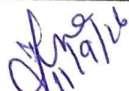
Resolved to initiate suitable measures through the Centre for IoT to facilitate internship opportunities for students during the Academic Year 2026–27.
