Resolved to start a peer review forum to support student writing and collaborative learning.

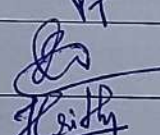
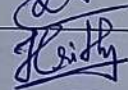
Item 1.4: To identify potential partnerships with other student clubs

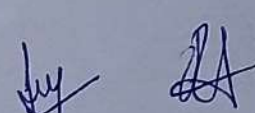
It was resolved to explore collaboration opportunities with the other clubs to conduct joint events that promote reading and communication skills.

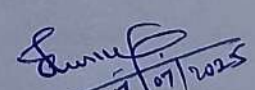
