The Principal and AO then addressed the gathering, appreciating the team's progress and sharing key points for further improvement. Following their remarks, the agenda items were taken up for discussion one by one.

1.1.To approve the participation in upcoming Educational Expos, the Coordinator explained the details of the proposed events and their relevance in promoting the institution. He presented the list of forthcoming expos and event allocations, referring to the discussions held in the previous meeting on 21.02.2025. The Coordinator highlighted how active participation in these expos would help strengthen the institution's outreach and admission prospects. - 1.1.To plan and organize all activities related to Result Day, the Coordinator explained the arrangements made for candidates to conveniently access their results on the day of the Result.
 - A provision was made for students to view their results, and printouts were provided for their reference.
 - Seamless Wi-Fi connectivity was arranged to enable candidates to check their results on their mobile phones and apply online for their preferred courses at the institution.

The Coordinator, Mr. Aravind, commenced the fourth meeting by welcoming all members and acknowledging their continued dedication to the admission process. He briefly reviewed the progress made since the previous meeting and emphasized the importance of sustaining momentum to achieve the institution's admission goals. The Principal and Administrative Officer addressed the committee, appreciating the team's coordinated efforts. The meeting then proceeded with the discussion of the listed agenda items.

1.1.To review and assess the overall admission performance for the academic year 2025–26, the Coordinator presented an analysis of the admission outcomes based on discussions from the previous meetings. A detailed review of the admission data was conducted, during which both the strengths and areas for improvement were discussed. The Coordinator highlighted the key factors that contributed to successful admissions as well as challenges faced during the process. The committee members shared their observations and provided suggestions to further enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of the admission process in the upcoming academic year.

Resolution: Resolved to document the findings of the admission review for the academic year 2025–26, incorporating both the strengths and areas for improvement discussed. It was further resolved that the insights gained from this review be utilized to refine future admission strategies and ensure better performance in the upcoming academic year.

- 1.2.To evaluate the current vacancy status across all programs, the Coordinator presented the updated data on available seats and discussed the same with the admission committee members.
 - The discussion focused particularly on the programs under Biosciences, Basic and Applied Sciences, and Humanities, where special attention is required to improve admissions.
 - The Coordinator highlighted the need for targeted follow-ups and focused promotional efforts in these areas to fill the remaining vacancies.
 - The committee members reviewed the status and agreed on the importance of continuous monitoring and proactive engagement to ensure optimal enrollment across all programs.

Resolution: Resolved to closely monitor the vacancy status across all programs and give special attention to Biosciences, Basic and Applied Sciences, and Humanities. - It was proposed that a general entrance examination be conducted to offer a 100% free scholarship to meritorious students.
- At the NPF software stage, an AI-based notification system is to be implemented to streamline communication.
- The Coordinator also emphasized that all fields in the campus software must be accurately filled out at the time of admission to ensure data completeness.
- Additionally, the implementation of an acknowledgement slip was suggested for the collection of original certificates from students.
- The committee further discussed strengthening marketing strategies to effectively reach potential students in rural areas. After detailed deliberation, the members agreed to incorporate these improvements for the next admission cycle.

Resolution: Resolved to implement the proposed process improvements and upgrades for the upcoming admission cycle, including the conduct of a general entrance examination for scholarship eligibility, integration of AI-based notifications in the NPF software, and completion of all required fields in the campus software during admission.
