# National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL)

Our institution being ranked at 100<sup>th</sup> position among 4500 local chapters and takes pride in creating awareness for all students, both UG and PG. The students are encouraged and motivated to register in several online platforms like NPTEL, MOOC, SWAYAM, Spoken Tutorial and

other free courses. Apart from students, the faculty members also have shown keen interest in enhancing their knowledge by joining in several courses. Totally 3464 students and 129 staffs have enrolled and completed different online courses. Four staff members were registered as mentor in International Marketing and Leadership NPTEL courses.

## **Examination Results**

The end semester examination results for the academic year 2022-23 for both UG and PG have been fruitful. The pass percentage for UG has been 97.05% and for PG 94.27% which is indicative of the fact that both undergraduate and postgraduate students are ambitious in clearing their exams.

# **Faculty Development Programme**

To enhance the knowledge of the staff and to be at par with the recent developments 78 FDP programs were conducted in-house. Out of these, some of them were functional FDPs conducted by the respective departments for their faculty. Some faculty visited other institutions and attended FDP which account to 552.
