MENTOR MENTEE INTERACTIONS

• It is mandatory to conduct minimum of 2 sessions of mentor mentee meetings per semester where the student is supposed to have interaction with the mentor. He or she must be aware of the competitions being held in and out of institutions and should be encouraged to participate and win awards. Explicitly, the highlight of the meeting should be to enable the student to choose a career path in order to pursue higher education or get placed in the industry. INTERNAL ACADEMIC AUDIT
