IQAC Annual Report AY 2025-26

Accreditation and Ranking

NIRF 2025: Our institution was ranked 66 under the college category during NIRF 2025.

India Today Ranking: Our college bagged 7th position in Arts Stream and 8th in Science Stream in India Today's Best Colleges of India 2025 survey in Tamil Nadu.

The Week: Hansa Best College Pan India Ranking 2025 conducted by THE WEEK, we secured 23rd rank in CDF, 42nd rank in BSc Programmes, 39th rank in Commerce, and 37th rank in Catering Science for the stream wise ranking.

Education World: Under Private Autonomous College Ranking 2025-26, we secured 17th rank Pan India and 4th rank in Tamil Nadu.

Institution Innovation Council (IIC): Our institution was highly engaged in fostering ideas on innovation and entrepreneurship which fetched a 3.5 Star rating by Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.

NPTEL: 842 students and 48 staff successfully completed multidisciplinary online courses, 316 candidates secured Elite Certificates, 84 of them secured Elite + Silver Certificates and 11 candidates were graded Elite + Gold Certificates.

NCAT 2025: For the past 5 consecutive years (2021–2025) our institution has been awarded Best Performing Institute in NCAT with maximum students able to clear the test. During AY 2025-26, 16 students secured All India Ranking with Ms. Kalaimathi, II M.Sc. Mathematics in the second place who won a cash Prize too.

CA and CMA Cleared during AY 2025-26: Professional examinations like CMA inter and CMA final were cleared by 2 and 1 student respectively. CA inter and CA final were cleared by 4 and 6 students respectively. CSEET was successfully completed by 37 students and 114 students completed MSME GST certification course.

Scholarships To Students: 3267 students received scholarship from the management to a tune of Rs. 3,03,44,607 under many categories.

Students and Staff Presentation: 1266 papers were presented in International and National level Conferences, Seminars and Symposiums. 689 paper presentations were made by faculty members and 948 by students.

Staff Recognitions

Our staff members have received national and international recognitions like- Best Social Worker Award, Shri P.K. Das Memorial Award for Best Faculty, Sir. CV Raman Award by Vaagai Tamil Sangam, Award for Excellence in Teaching, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Award by Vaagai Tamil Sangam are a few to name. Our faculty have the privilege of serving as University Nominee (4 members), Doctoral Committee nominee (83 staff members), subject expert in Board of Studies (37 members) which truly showcases that the faculty are at par with the new technology, skill and knowledge. Rich experience in research gained laurels to 68 faculty as reviewers in national and international journals, 33 faculty have contributed as editorial members. The professional interest of our staff led them to be active members in many professional bodies, where 238 of them have registered in different academic and professional bodies as annual or life members.

Admission And Graduates

The admission during the AY 2025-26 had a count of 2247 for UG and 379 for PG and the number of graduates in UG & PG were 2018 and 368 respectively indicating 98.5% result. The student staff ratio (1:16) is very encouraging with 445 staff with student strength of 7011.

Centres, Committees, Cells And Clubs

The institution proudly functions with 18 Centres, 15 Cells, 19 clubs, and 25 committees each with co-ordinators and staff members along with student representatives. All the above work in close accordance with Days of National and International Observance, Themes/Schemes of Govt. of India to meet the challenges which spans over 150 activities. The activities include 20 awareness programs, 15 extension activities, 5 societal camps and other programs 110.

Students Recognitions: 685 students from our institution have received awards and prizes in several cultural programs, Quiz competition, Best Project Award, Oral presentation, Best Paper Presentation held at different institutions both at regional and national level. Mr. Sarankumar A,

Department of AI & ML received the prestigious international scholarship and was selected for research fellowship under TEEP (Taiwan Experience Education Program) at Taiwan. Ms. Kavya J,

Department of Computer Science received another prestigious internship scholarship and selected for research fellowship at IIT, Ropar.

Research And Development

Seminar/conference/Projects: Our institution received funding for seminar, conference and research projects from various Government agencies like ICSSR, DBT-CTEP, DST-ANRF, AICTE, NHRC and ICWA to a tune of Rs. 28,50,680.

Funded Scheme: Under DBT Star College Scheme a sum of Rs.33,00,000 was received towards scientific research and development for the undergraduate students of DBT Star College Scheme departments and the additional ones. TN Startup and DST FIST granted a sum of Rs. 7,50,000 and Rs.57,00,00 respectively for skill development, research and innovation.

Corporate Funded Seminar

International Conference on Digital Innovation and Transformation with Emerging Trends for Sustainable Development was organized in collaboration with Vidyalkar School of Management, Mumbai on January 23 & 24, 2026 where more than 900 participants registered and we received 300 articles for publication. Partial funding (Rs.30,000) was received from Corporates belonging to Coimbatore and Mumbai.

Research Paper Publications: A total of 1105 papers, 90 Books, 197 book chapters were published, out of which 217 are listed in Scopus and 24 in Web of Science (inclusive of conference proceedings). Some papers have evolved out of collaborative work with other institutions across the globe.

Patent/Copyright: 106 Patents and 3 Copyrights were published in various titles during AY 2025-26 across all disciplines.

Award of Ph.D. Degree: Total of 27 research scholars were awarded doctoral degree in various disciplines during the academic year 2025-26 which marks the research potential at our institution.

Consultancy: A sum of Rs.10,88,314/- has been generated by our Staff and Students through training programs and services to peer group, industries, researchers, academicians and the public spread across 115 organizations.

MoU and Collaborations: 79 MoU are currently active in our institution out of which 5 were signed with international institutions in Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand and Laos.

Training And Placement: 55 on campus interviews and 11 off campus interviews were organized where 1395 students were placed during AY 2025-26 with the highest package of Rs. 9 lakhs per annum. 343 students were trained on Career Readiness and Employability and 1836 of them were actively a part of Cognitive Skill Enhancement Part – I (odd semester) and Part -II (even semester) who received certificates upon successful completion of the training programmes. This exercise enhanced better placement opportunities to the individual students and all-round development.

DBT Star College Activities: Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India, has accorded Star College Status to our institution. A Grant-in-aid sum of Rs.1.26 crores was sanctioned based on the outstanding performance in the field of Science and Technology. A total of 33 guest lectures, 60 seminars and exhibition, 147 workshops (both organized and attended) 44 hands on training programs, 27 outreach activities, 16 industrial visits were organized by both the DBT Star College Scheme departments and the additional departments. A total Grant-in-Aid of sum of Rs. 33,00,000/- was sanctioned by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India for the AY 2025-26.

iSTEM Member: Our institution is an active member of the iSTEM lining researchers and resources which allows to utilize the high end equipment present in the basic and applied science and bioscience laboratories in order to foster the spirit of Aatma Nirbhar Bharat among the researchers.

Sports Achievement 2025-26: Our students have represented the National, State and regional level championship and won 26 gold medals, 34 silver and 13 bronze medals in various events. Mr. R.R. Revanth Ram of III B.Com CSCA won Gold Medal in the World Raw Powerlifting Federation Asia Championship 2026 held at New Delhi during February 2026. Our Sports team actively participated in All India Inter University Volleyball Tournament held at Manipal University, Jaipur, All India Inter University Basketball Tournament held at University of Mumbai, Mumbai and the All India Inter University Athletics Championship held at Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Science, Karnataka.

National Service Scheme (NSS): Our institution has 150 NSS volunteers who participated in many community services, to name a few - International Yoga Day, Choose life not drug, and Campus Cleaning event. One week long 7 days camp on the theme “Youth for My Bharath and Digital Literacy for Youth” was conducted at Veeriyampalayam village to energize the villagers

with yoga session, healthy living tips, digital transformation and cultural activities. Under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan theme, our students empowered housewives of the adopted villages by enhancing practical skills in masala and health mix preparation, while providing basic knowledge on branding, pricing, and promotion, thereby enabling income generation and supporting their transition towards sustainable small-scale entrepreneurship

NCC: Enthusiastic and challenging 2 TN CTC NCC Army Wing of our institution attended many Basic and Advanced camps Pan India. They also underwent rigorous training in Basic Mountaineering Course, Thal Sainik Camp, Marina Republic Day Camp (MRDC), Service Selection Board (SSB) training camp, and NCC Army Attachment Camp. They inaugurated the N.G.P. Obstacle Course and the Firing Range, organized World Water Day camp and Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat camp. A historic milestone was achieved by our cadets who represented the entire Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, and Andaman & Nicobar (TN, PY & AN) Directorate at the prestigious All India Pre-Monsoon Mountaineering Expedition at Manali from 18 May 2026 to 25 May 2026 setting a benchmark of excellence for the entire unit.

Centre for Indian Knowledge System: The Centre for Indian Knowledge System (IKS) & Value Education conducted an Online Quiz to observe World Health Day and to promote health awareness among students. The Centre also organized a guest lecture on “Introduction to IKS Concept and Classification: Road Map to Viksat Bharat 2047” to deepen students’ understanding of IKS. Adding to its achievements, the Coordinator of the Centre, Dr. V. Nijarubini, Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry, was selected to present the proposal for the development of the SWAYAM MOOC course on Indian Knowledge Systems & Environment before the UGC Expert Committee as part of the evaluation process. These initiatives reflect the Centre’s efforts to strengthen Indian Knowledge Systems, cultivate awareness, and support academic excellence.

DrNGP Beginners Business Council (BBC): has successfully incubated 25 student-led startups, fostering innovation and entrepreneurial growth on campus. The Council has conducted 12 workshops and awareness sessions to strengthen entrepreneurial competencies and industry readiness. Additionally, over 20 internship opportunities have been facilitated through incubated startups, with 4 ventures currently generating active revenue namely Prefenzo Technologies Private Limited, My VitaBowl, Jeevan Digital Tech Solutions and Byte Club. We have also provided a skill development training program under the name Bioinfoga 2026 : Advanced training on computational biology.

Student Quality Assurance Cell (SQAC): Dr. NGPASC has been keen on initiating SQAC meetings held at the end of every semester not only to create a bonding between the students, faculty and the institution but also to instill career progression, culture of responsibility, assessing and improving the effectiveness of student services like counseling, career guidance, extracurricular activities. Feedback was collected on the above from students through online Google forms. SQAC is equipped with compilation of data on upskilling of students who were motivated to take up online courses beyond curriculum.

Institutional Development Plan: Departmental Progress Quality Enhancement Plan (DPQEP) was planned for department and individual faculty members for excellence in academics and research. It revolves around student centric environment, collaborative initiatives, international exchange programs, research publications, product development and patents. On the career progression angle, it focusses on skill enhancement, Value added courses, training programmes for students and initiation of activities in club, committee, centres and cells by organizing seminar, conferences and workshops. At the end of the academic year each department has presented their DPQEP by accomplishing their targets.

Mentor Mentee Interactions: The structure and implementation for Mentor Mentee interactions is recorded in a booklet for every student. The key emphasis is on career progression evolved from skill and knowledge development nurtured through mentoring sessions. Care is taken to provide goal setting, professional growth with active networking, and to transform each student into an accountable, responsible individual. The effect of mentoring sessions was analyzed through feedback mechanism where the students cherished the mechanism as it was a one to one interaction towards accelerated learning, improved guidance towards building more confidence and a better individual.

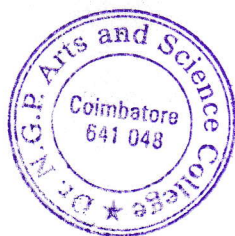
