## College Day Report 2025-2026

Dr. N.G.P. Arts and Science College is a part of **Dr. N.G. P. Research and Educational Trust** which was established in the year 1997 under the leadership of our Chairman Dr. Nalla G. Palaniswami, and Madam Secretary Dr. Thavamani D. Palaniswami. The Institution has begun with four Undergraduate programmes namely B.Sc. Biochemistry, B.Sc. Computer Science, B.Com. and B.B.M. with a student strength of 78 and 9 Faculty members. The institution presently offers 33 UG courses, 17 PG courses and 25 research programmes (Ph.D.) The University Grants Commission, New Delhi has recognized our college under 2(f) and 12(B) and conferred autonomous status from the Academic year 2015-16. The college was re-accredited by NAAC with A<sup>++</sup> Grade and CPGA of 3.64 out of 4. The institution exhibits a steadfast achievement in attaining 66<sup>th</sup> Rank National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF). In addition, Dr.NGPASC Institution Innovation Council secured 3.5-star rating by MoE's Innovation Cell. The institution has been recognized as the SIRO by DSIR Ministry of Science and Technology. The Institution has been granted funds to undertake major and minor research projects, and conduct seminars, conferences and workshops by various funding agencies like UGC, DRDO, ICMR, ICSSR, CSIR, DST, DBT, AICTE and TNSCST. The College exercises 43 Best Practices to enhance the holistic development of the students.

83 Memoranda of Understanding have been executed to facilitate collaboration between the educational institution and industry, fostering joint research endeavors, workforce development, technology transfer, and curriculum alignment.

## **Government Scholarship**

The institution actively encourages students to apply for Central and State Government scholarships at UG, PG, and Research levels. A total of 210 students were benefited, receiving ₹25,20,000 through the Pudhumai Penn Scholarship 234 students received ₹28,08,000 through the Tamil Pudhalvan scheme. Nearly 380 students received the SC/ST Scholarship amounting to ₹18,71,490.

## **Institution Scholarship**

For the academic year **2025-2026**, an estimable total of **3,264** students were generously granted concessions amounting to **Rs. 3,74,44,907/-** (Three Crore Seventy-Four Lakh Lakh Forty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven) showcasing our unwavering commitment for imparting quality education that is accessible to all meritorious in academics and sports. This approach reflects the management's dedication to nurturing talent, promoting inclusivity, and building a brighter future for all students. 90 sports students have been granted with **100%** free education and accommodation under sports scholarship to the sum of **Rs. 1,15,00,000**.

### **National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL)**

During the academic year 2025–2026, the college recorded a significant achievement in its NPTEL Local Chapter performance, securing the 100<sup>th</sup> position among the Top 100 Local Chapters out of nearly 4,500 participating institutions across India. In the NPTEL examinations, 38 faculty members and 721 students successfully completed various courses. Among them, 256 students and 8 faculty members earned the Elite certification, while 64 students and 17 faculty members secured the Elite Silver certification. In addition, 14 students and 5 faculty members achieved the prestigious Elite Gold certification, reflecting the strong academic engagement and commitment of both students and faculty members.

The institution also promotes the development of industry-relevant skills through certification programmes offered by the National Council of Vocational and Research Training (NCVRT). These programmes aim to enhance students' employability and practical competencies. During the current academic year, 157 students are pursuing eight different skill development courses under NCVRT.

### **Examination Results**

In the recently held Comprehensive Examinations in November 2025, 83.30 % PG students and 86.25 % UG students have successfully passed their courses.

- The faculty members from various departments have generated a consultancy revenue of ₹1,88,500/- during the academic year, reflecting the institution's commitment to extending academic expertise and professional services to industry and society.

### **Membership in Academic Bodies**

The academic expertise of our faculty members has been widely recognized and extended to several institutions. A total of 92 faculty members have been serving as Board of Studies (BoS) members, Viva Voce examiners, and Doctoral Committee members in various colleges and universities across Tamil Nadu, contributing significantly to academic development and quality enhancement in higher education.

### **RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT:**

Research and Development is one of the key focus areas of the institution, aimed at promoting innovation, knowledge creation, and academic excellence. The college actively encourages faculty members and students to engage in research activities through funded projects, publications, patents, seminars, workshops, and collaborative initiatives.

- Our college received Rs.1,25,95,438 for strengthening undergraduate education at college level in sciences from Department of Biotechnology under DBT STAR Status Scheme.
- A grant of Rs.22 lakhs was released in the academic year 2025-26 for four-Star Status Department, which includes Microbiology, Biochemistry, Food Science and Nutrition, & Biotechnology.
- Department of Biotechnology under DBT STAR college Scheme sanctioned Rs. 62,30,583 in which a grant of Rs.11 lakhs was released in the academic year 2025-26 for the additional Department, which includes Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Computer Science.
- Dr. M.N. Kathiravan, professor Department of Biotechnology and Dr. Senthilkumar Professor, Department of Computer Science received Rs. Rs. 57,00,000/- for the establishment of a Centralized Instrumental Lab from DST, Govt. of India SR/FIST.

### **Startups**

Dr. N.G.P. Beginners Business Council (BBC) has successfully incubated 25 student-led startups, fostering innovation and entrepreneurial growth on campus. The Council has conducted 12 workshops and awareness sessions to strengthen entrepreneurial competencies and industry readiness. Additionally, over 20 internship opportunities have been facilitated through incubated startups, with 4 ventures currently generating active revenue namely Prefenzo Technologies Private Limited, My VitaBowl, Jeevan Digital Tech Solutions and Byte Club.

38 Books, 137 Book Chapters and 285 research articles were published by our staff members in various refereed SCI/WoS/Scopus/UGC Care National / International peer-reviewed reputed journals.

### **Recognitions and Awards**

A total of 222 students and 55 faculty members received recognitions and prizes from various Government and Non-Government agencies for their outstanding achievements in academic, co-curricular, extracurricular, and sports activities.

### **Award of Ph.D.**

During the academic year 2025–2026, the college proudly produced 23 Ph.D. scholars, reflecting its strong commitment to research and academic excellence.

### **Patents Filed**

During the academic year 2025–2026, a total of 51 patents were filed under Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) by the faculty and researchers of the institution, demonstrating the college's growing emphasis on innovation and research contributions.

### **Extension Activities**

A total of 24 extension activities were organized during the academic year with the participation of 913 students, aimed at benefiting rural communities. These activities focused on health, hygiene and sanitation, biodiversity, and environmental conservation. The institution has adopted several villages for community outreach, including Nellithurai, Thippanur, Agrahasamakulam, Velliangadu, and Padhvampalli, where these initiatives were actively implemented.

### **Training and Placement**

A dedicated Training and Placement Cell have been established to facilitate career opportunities for students. The training programmes are designed to focus on the holistic development of students, enhancing their technical knowledge, aptitude skills, and soft skills to meet industry expectations.

During the academic year 2025–2026

- 60 companies visited the campus for recruitment.
- 1,328 students were successfully placed in various reputed organizations.
- The highest salary package offered was ₹9.1 lakh per annum.
- The Training and Placement Cell achieved an impressive placement rate of 85% among eligible students.

### **Club Activities**

28 Centers 36 Committees and 18 clubs, 2 Centers for Excellence namely Centre for Internet of Things (IoT) and the Centre for Regional Languages are functioning to support the overall development of students' character and team building. 118 activities were organized through various centers, committees and clubs so as to improve the co-curricular and extracurricular skills in which 5,800 students were benefited.
