MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

INTI International University, Nilai, Malaysia

And

Dr. N.G.P. Arts and Science College, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, India

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is entered into on this 20th day of June, 2025,

By and between:

Dr. N.G.P. Arts and Science College, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, India (hereafter "NGPASC"), established by the Dr. N.G.P. Research and Educational Trust, Coimbatore in 1997 and affiliated to Bharathiar University, Coimbatore.

And

INTI INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY operated by **INTI INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION SDN BHD** [Company No. 199401043150 (328838-A)] company incorporated under the laws of Malaysia, with its business address at Persiaran Perdana BBN, Putra Nilai, 71800 Nilai, Negeri Sembilan (hereinafter referred to as "INTI")

Article 1: Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for academic cooperation, exchange, and mutual support between **INTI** and **NGPASC**. The institutions aim to foster joint research, capacity building, academic exchange, and collaborative programs in areas of shared interest.

Article 2: Areas of Collaboration

The following areas are identified for potential collaboration:

1. Faculty exchange
2. Student exchange
3. Joint research and publications
4. Research Collaboration and Co-supervision



5. Organization of joint seminars, conferences, and workshops
6. Short-term certificate and micro-credential programs
7. Staff development and training
8. Professional study tours and customized academic visits
9. Any other mutually agreed activity aligned with the institutions' academic missions

Article 3: Implementation

Specific activities under this MoU will be detailed in individual Memoranda of Agreement (MoA) or similar documents. These will include clear terms, objectives, roles, financial arrangements, and timelines, and will be annexed to this MoU.

Article 4: Financial Arrangements

- 4.1 Each institution will be responsible for its own expenses unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- 4.2 Any joint initiative requiring shared funding will be governed by separate written agreements.

Article 5: Coordination

- 5.1. Each party shall appoint a coordinator to facilitate communication, monitor activities, and ensure compliance with the terms of this MoU.
- 5.2. All formal communication and any modifications must be made in writing and approved by the Head of the Institutions.

Article 6: Validity and Termination

- 6.1. This MoU is valid for **Five (5) years** from the date of signing and comes into effect upon execution by both parties.
- 6.2. It may be terminated by either party with six (6) months' written notice, provided through registered or speed post.



6.3. Ongoing activities will continue to conclusion as per their respective MoUs. Termination of this MoU terminates all annexed agreements unless specified otherwise.

Article 7: Renewal

7.1. This MoU may be renewed for an additional **Five (5)** years by mutual written agreement.

7.2. Revisions or modifications to this MoU must also be mutually agreed upon in writing.

Article 8: Amendments and Dispute Resolution

8.1. This MoU may be amended only by a written agreement signed by Head of the Institutions.

8.2. In the event of disputes or unforeseen issues, both parties will work in good faith to resolve them through mutual dialogue.

8.3. In cases of interpretation disputes, the parties shall attempt to resolve differences amicably and collaboratively.

Article 9: Intellectual Property Rights

Any intellectual property (e.g., patents, publications) arising from joint work shall be governed by a separate agreement made **prior to** the commencement of such work.

Both parties agree to respect and protect each other's intellectual property in accordance with their national laws.

Article 10: Matters Not Covered

Any matters not explicitly addressed in this MoU shall be resolved through mutual consultation, guided by the prevailing policies and statutory regulations of the respective institutions.

Article 11: Headings

Headings in this MoU are for reference only and do not influence the interpretation of the clauses.



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Article 12: No Partnership

This MoU does not create a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the parties. Each institution remains independent and responsible for its own actions.

Article 13: No Employer-Employee Relationship

This MoU does not establish an employer-employee relationship between the institutions or their personnel involved in the collaborative activities.

Article 14: Communication

This MoU is subject to the Force Majeure of any event arising in any form.



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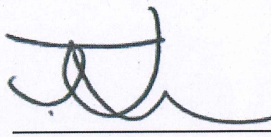
