### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred as "MoU") is made on 17.2.2026 in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, India.

By and Between

The Dr. N.G.P. Arts and Science College (Dr. NGPASC), Dr. N.G.P. Nagar, Kalapatti Road, Coimbatore-641 048, represented by its Principal Prof. Dr. S. Saravanan (hereinafter referred to as "First Party", the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns).

And

KGM-Skillryt, 365, Thudiyalur Road, Saravanampatti, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu 641035 represented by Mr. Aravind Kumar Rajendran (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns).





First Party and Second Party shall be hereinafter collectively referred to as “Parties” and individually as a “Party”.

**WHEREAS:**

1. First Party is a Higher Education Institution named **Dr. N.G.P. Arts and Science College**. It is a co-educational self-financing autonomous institution, affiliated to Bharathiar University, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu offering undergraduate, postgraduate & Doctoral programmes in Arts, Science and Management. The institution is recognized under 2(F) & 12(B) and conferred autonomous status during the academic year 2015-16 by University Grants Commission, New Delhi and is accredited with A++ Grade (3rd Cycle) by NAAC. Eight science departments are recognized under DBT-STAR Scheme.
2. **KGM-Skillryt**, an upskilling startup, has expertise in industry-oriented skill training for multiple industries including multiple domains of the technology sector.
3. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
4. The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation in the areas of Skill-Based Training, Internship Opportunities, Joint Research Initiatives and Knowledge Exchange.
5. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests.
6. The Parties are desirous of entering into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter be referred to as “MoU”) to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of cooperation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

**THE PARTIES HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING ON THE FOLLOWING MATTERS**

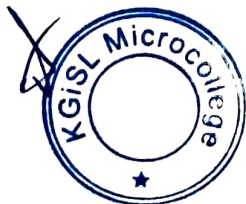
**1. OBJECTIVE**

The MoU sets out the framework and areas of academia-industry cooperation which may be of mutual interest and benefit to both Parties. In order to pursue the above objectives and forms of cooperation, either Party may also propose fields of cooperation of mutual benefit for consideration by the other Party.

**2. AREAS OF COOPERATION**

Both parties agree to encourage the following activities, in particular, to promote academia-industry cooperation in the following areas:

- 2.1) Joint initiatives in education and collaborative research.
- 2.2) Organization of industry-academia workshops, seminars and conferences.



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- 2.3) Joint mentoring and guidance for hackathons, competitions and innovation challenges.
- 2.4) Exchange of training resources, project documentation and technical publications.
- 2.5) Collaborative support for academic projects, internships and student placements.

### **3. EFFECT OF THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This MoU is not intended to be legally binding but it simply expresses the intentions and understanding between both Parties. The Parties may enter into a legally binding Memorandum of Agreement while incorporating terms from this MoU.

### **4. NO AGENCY**

The relationship between the Parties will be non-exclusive in nature. The MoU does not prevent a Party from entering into arrangements with other third parties. Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organization of any kind between the Parties or to make either Party the agent of the other.

### **5. ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION**

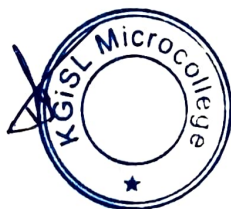
- 5.1) This MoU shall become effective from the date of signing by both Parties
- 5.2) This MoU will remain in effect for a period of one year.
- 5.3) This MoU may be extended for such further period as agreed in writing by both Parties.

### **6. REVISION, VARIATION AND AMENDMENT**

- 6.1) Either Party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of this MoU.
- 6.2) Any such revision, variation or amendment agreed to by the Parties in any clause of the MoU shall be mutually agreed by both the parties.
- 6.3) Such revision, variation or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties.
- 6.4) Any revision, variation or amendment shall not prejudice the implementation of any project, activity or co-operation arising from or based on this MoU before or up to the date of such revision, variation or amendment.

### **7. TERMINATION**

This MoU may be terminated by either Party with a minimum of THIRTY (30) days written notice from one Party to the other. Activities in progress at the time of termination of this MoU shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.



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## 8. NOTICES

Any communication between the Parties under this MoU shall be in writing in the English language and delivered by registered mail to the postal address or sent to the electronic mail address as stated herein, be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the recipient at such postal address or electronic mail address.

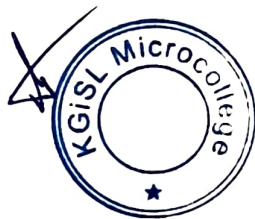

### Representation and Warranties:

#### Each Party represents and warrants to the other as follows:

1. It shall, during the term of this Agreement, comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and regulatory requirements and codes of practice in carrying out its obligations under this Agreement and in all matters relating hereto, and shall not knowingly do anything or procure or permit anything to be done that might cause or otherwise result in a breach of the same by the other Party.
2. There is no litigation, claims, actions or governmental investigations of any nature pending against it, and it has not received notice of any such legal proceeding, claim, action or governmental investigation against it nor has it any knowledge of any such threatened proceedings, claim, action or governmental investigation, which relates in any manner to this Agreement or the transactions contemplated hereby or which could adversely impact its ability to perform its obligations under this Agreement.

**Each party undertakes:**

1. To co-operate fully with the other, and with the other's employees, agents and contractors, with a view to facilitate and enhance the Parties' performance of their respective obligations hereunder;
2. Not to use, publish or disclose any information or material produced or supplies by the other Party under this agreement, without the other Party's prior written consent, for any purposes other than those contemplated under this Agreement; and
3. To promptly inform the other Party of any claims or complaints of which the informing Party becomes aware relating to the other Party or its activities in connection with its performance under this Agreement.

**Resolution of Disputes:**

- a) This agreement shall take effect and be governed by and construed in accordance with the Laws of India and shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts at Coimbatore.
- b) In the event of dispute or difference whatsoever arises between Parties in relation to or in connection with this agreement both the parties shall first attempt to resolve the dispute/difference amicably through mutual discussions. If the dispute or difference is not resolved amicably within a reasonable period, the same shall be referred to and finally settled through arbitration. The arbitration proceedings shall be held in accordance with the provision of Indian Arbitration and Reconciliation Act, 1996. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted by a sole arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties. The seat and venue of arbitration shall be Coimbatore, India and language of arbitration shall be conducted in the English language. The arbitral award shall be final and binding on the Parties.

**Amendment:**

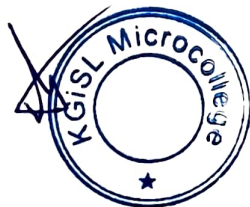
Any amendments, modifications or supplements to this MoU must be made in writing and signed by the authorized representatives of both the Parties to become effective.

**Confidentially:**

The terms and conditions of this MoU are confidential between the Parties and shall not be disclosed to anyone else, except as may be necessary to effectuate its objectives.

**Compliance with Laws:**

Each Party shall comply in all respects with all applicable laws, regulations and legal requirements governing its respective duties, obligations, and business practices under this MoU, and shall obtain and maintain all necessary permits, approvals or licenses for



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its operations. Neither Party shall take any action in violation of any applicable legal requirement that could result in liability being imposed on the other Party.

**Entire Agreement:**

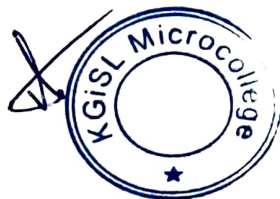
This MoU constitutes the entire Agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter of this MoU and supersedes all prior Agreements, understandings and negotiations, whether written or oral, with respect to such subject matter.

**Renewal of Memorandum of Understanding:**

On the expiry of the Term, this MoU may be renewed by signing a fresh agreement upon mutually agreeable terms and conditions. In witness whereof, the parties hereto, through their authorized representatives, have executed this “MoU” as on the date, month and the year first above written. The parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth above as demonstrated by their signature as follows

**TERMS AND AGREEMENT**

01. The industry agrees to offer the course entitled “MERN Stack” for a duration of 30 hours on payment basis as agreed mutually by both the parties.
02. The main objective of KGM-Skillryt and College is to impart quality Training/Education Services to the students of the College.
03. Industry agrees to provide Experts to conduct the Value-Added Courses at the College premises.
04. College agrees to provide Class rooms / labs for conducting the Value-Added Courses.
05. Certificate will be provided by Party 2 in the name of “MERN Stack” after completion of the assessment, thereafter payment will be processed from the College.
06. Industry shall make provision for modification, improvements or changes suggested by the College on agreeable terms.
07. The duration of the MoU shall be for the proposed batch and shall be extended there after by mutual consent if the activity is satisfactory to the College (Party 1).
08. For all interactions and execution of this MoU, for the College, the Head of the Department concerned will be the contact person and for KGM-Skillryt, will be the contact person for the Company (Party 2).
09. Through this agreement, the second year and final year students of FCS, during the 2025 - 2026 academic year, will receive training for the “MERN Stack”
10. The total training session will consist of 30 hours of offline instructions, to be completed within the corresponding academic year.
11. The company agrees to deliver the training syllabus already shared with and approved by the college.
12. Course fee and terms and conditions for future courses may be revised as mutually agreed by both the parties.



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13. All the decisions should be made with the consent of the Principal, NGP and KGM-Skillryt.
14. Courses shall be conducted only during the timings mutually agreed upon by both parties.
15. In addition to the Industry Expert, the College will provide a Course Coordinator to ensure the smooth conduct of the course.
16. Assessments shall be conducted upon completion of the course.
17. The course certificate must be provided in hard copy.
18. It is also mutually agreed upon by both parties that the courses, once offered, will be completed in all aspects. Both parties are responsible for the smooth conduct of the planned courses neither causing any damage to the College property nor any hardship to the students.

**Payment Terms:**

- The fee to be paid by Party 1 after the satisfactory completion of the training is Rs. 1,000/- per student. The total amount will depend on the number of students participating.
- GST is exempted as per NSDC certification.
- Payment should be made by the College in the form of a Demand Draft or Cheque, payable in the name of "KGISL Microcollege".
