Memorandum of Understanding

Dr NGP Arts and Science College, Coimbatore

Represented by The Principal

AND

Vellalar College for Women, Erode

Represented by The Principal



This Memorandum of Understanding is intended to promote cooperation between Dr NGP Arts and Science College (Autonomous), Coimbatore (Herein after referred to as Dr NGPASC), UGC approved, accredited by the NAAC with 'A++' Grade in the Third cycle, ranked no. 75 in NIRF 25, affiliated to Bharathiar University, Coimbatore represented by its Principal Dr. S.Saravanan, Herein after referred to as the FIRST PARTY OF ONE PART

AND

Vellalar College for Women, Thindal, Erode (Herein after referred to as VCW), conferred with the status of Autonomy in 2007, affiliated to Bharathiar University, College with Potential for Excellence in 2011, recognized under the UGC PARAMARSH scheme for 2019-2021, Re-accredited by NAAC with 'A+' grade (Cycle IV) in 2022, ISO-9001 certified, represented by its Principal, herein after referred to as the SECOND PARTY OF OTHER PART. NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein, the PARTIES agree as follows:

Clause.1 Objectives

- 1.1 To associate in providing innovative courses, student and faculty exchange training and research programmes at DRNGPASC and VCW.
- 1.2. To collaborate in organising seminars and workshops.
- 1.3. To collaborate in conducting outreach programmes in the community

Clause 2. Implementation

2.1.The PARTIES agree to form an Implementation Committee comprising the following members:

- i) Principal, Dr. N.G.P. Arts and Science College, Coimbatore
- ii) Principal, Vellalar College for Women, Erode

Clause 3. General Provisions

- 3.1 Based on the requirements, the implementation committee shall, in consultation with the faculty and professionals, decide on program/event and the mode of cooperation during the tenure of this collaboration.
- 3.2 The institution organising an item of works shall have the nodal responsibility for mobilizing resources and the conduct of such works.
- 3.3 Each PARTY shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligation under this agreement. Neither party shall make a claim against the other party for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the parties.
- 3.4 Any disputes or differences arising between the parties shall be settled by mutual agreement. The disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to the respective higher officials for appropriate resolution.
- 3.5 Nothing in this understanding is intended to affect other cooperation or collaboration between the parties.

Clause 4. Tenure and Termination

- 4.1 This MoU shall become effective from **January 27, 2026** upon signatures by the authorized signatories of the parties and shall be valid for five years. It may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon one month's written notice to the other party.
- 4.2 All joint activities that are in progress at the time of expiration or termination of this MoU may continue until their completion under the terms of this MoU.

Clause 5. Amendments

5.1 This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) represents the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes any and all understandings either oral or written with respect to the subject matter of this understanding.

5.2 No amendment, modification, or addition to this MoU shall be valid unless it is made in writing, duly signed by authorized representatives of both PARTIES, and explicitly stated as an amendment to this MoU. Such modifications shall become an integral part of this MoU and shall take effect from the date of execution, unless otherwise mutually agreed upon by the PARTIES.

Clause 6. Assignment

6.1 This MoU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each PARTY.

6.2 Therefore, neither PARTY shall transfer or assign this agreement, or any rights or obligations arising hereunder, in whole or in part, to any third party.

This MoU has been executed in two originals, one of which has been retained by Vellalar College for Women and the other by Dr. NGPASC.


