DEPARTMENT OF TAMIL

LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER

Central Library has emerged as a knowledge resource centre paying attention to the information needs of the faculty, research scholars and students. The library is shelved as an independent department in the campus with a floor area of nearly 10500 sq.ft. Automation of this library consisting over 35,000 books and documents, newly arrived books in this academic year(2016-17) are 2,500 and it also provides access over 3 Crore and above electronic books, 7500 and Database Available - CMIE Prowess, N – LIST, ScienceDirect, EBSCOhost and IEEE Xplore Digital Library. E –Journals and databases in Biosciences, Computer technology, social sciences and management. The library made a significant progress during the year.

Collection Development and Management is one of the important functions of the library that supports academic and research work of the students, faculty, staff and other users. Library collection comprising of books, journals, theses, reports, and other reading material in science, Computer technology, Commerce and management and is its greatest asset. Central Library is facilitated with 220 Indian journals, 10 Foreign journals and 1750 CDs and Digital books. Average number of Students visiting the library per day – 550, Average number of Books issued per day – 400, Available of Internet - 50 Mbps.

A list of new additions of books and reports is issued every fortnightly and can be accessed on the library home page. An E - Mail alert is also sent to the all faculty member(s) and Students about the arrival of publications requested by them and we sent following information. Sharing of Resource in the library maintains excellent relations with UGC InfoNet - Digital Library Consortium (N-LIST). So our staff and student community may use ILL services to obtain articles not owned by the central library.

The library loaned 60371 books and other documents to its members during the year and the library has an average of 1, 07,333 Users per year. IAS Academy Library is also equipped with latest editions of books for various competitive examinations. The library also provides reprography and print out facility for students and staff members.

PLACEMENT CELL
