ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Clinical Laboratory Technology, established in the year 2005 offers a unique three year undergraduate programme with a vision to provide high quality education to the students with hands on experience in the state of the art laboratories. The programme was meticulously designed to offer specialization in science stream encompassing a strong knowledge in clinical laboratory techniques and an exposure to social disciplines. The curriculum facilitates the students to acquire diverse knowledge in the field of Biochemistry, Microbiology, Pathology, Immunology, and Molecular biology. The Department of Clinical Laboratory Technology caters to the quest for knowledge in clinical diagnostic technology, with latest application tools.

The programme was initiated with the primary objective of improving the employability and interdisciplinary skills among the students and to meet out the increasing demand for technologists in the area of health care and related industries. Clinical laboratory technologists perform complex chemical, biochemical, hematological, immunological,



microscopic and bacteriological tests and evaluate test results. They develop and modify procedures and monitor programs to ensure the accuracy of tests. The curriculum renders supportive services to the field of medicine. Excellent job opportunities and prospects for rapid job growth are the highlights of this field.

The department successfully produced 11 batches of students since inception. The success of the department is judged by the placement of our alumni in National and International laboratories. We are thankful to the management, particularly our chairman and the secretary for providing a healthy atmosphere for learning, research, autonomy to our department for the growth and welfare of the student's community.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE DEPARTMENT

- The Department of Clinical Laboratory Technology focuses on laboratory science.
- Well equipped laboratory with advanced and higher end instruments that facilitates students to enrich practical skills in emerging tools and techniques.
- The students are trained to take up routine work in different areas of the laboratory such as Clinical Biochemistry, Microbiology, Pathology, Blood banking, Immunology and Molecular Biology.
- The students are given opportunities to take up internship in reputed laboratories/research institutes during their course period.
- Research project in the final year helps the students to gain confidence in continuing their career in research.
- The courses offered are B.Sc. Clinical Lab Technology and Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Lab Technology.
- Staff student ratio is 1:24 and number of batches produced in UG is 11.
- 16 university rank holders, 100% pass percentage and 21 first class with distinction adds credit to the department.
- UGC major project was sanctioned with amount of Rs 14,13,800 on the topic "Molecular Mechanism of Cardio Protective Activity of Crude and Active Principle of Garcinia indica in experimentally Induced Cardiac Toxicity in Rats".
- 32 research papers were published in National and International Journals with the average impact factor of 2.5.
- The department provides platform for knowledge sharing with scientists and industrial experts through conferences and seminars.
