The most common cause for drought is failure of rain because of the fall The tanks, wells and similar underground water reservoir remain unchanged. As a result there is no enough water available through hand pumps, wells and other traditional sources that depend on underground reservoir of water. Dry parched lands wherein cracks have developed, failed crops, starving cattle and human beings are common sights in newspapers during the drought season. Acute scarcity of water leads to human misery in multiple forms. There is no food or fodder. Drinking water is scarce. Wells dry up. There is no water in the traditional tanks. Families move out of their homes to distant places in search of employment.

DROUGHTS EFFECTS:

Farmers are the worst to suffer when the rain fails. They lose crops and are left with no fodder for their cattle. Repeated droughts cut down the volume of agricultural production. Insufficient market supplies push up prices of foods grains making them beyond the reach of poor people. Since these people have little or no savings, they become the worst victims of famine conditions. People living in desert lands have to face water scarcity even in normal times. Their condition becomes worse under drought conditions. Children are also the worst victims of drought conditions. Newspapers carry horrible tales of children having been sold by starving parents. These children end up as bonded laborers or get forced into yet more degrading occupations. Their schooling gets disrupted and any hopes for their future lie shattered.

THE "CAPE TOWN" CRISIS:

Recently, Cape Town also has become infamous as the home of "Day Zero," the day when most of the city's tapes are predicted to run dry. With its major, rain-fed supply dams dangerously low after three years of drought, most of the city's 4 million-plus residents -some rich, many desperately-poor - have been facing the prospect of lining up at emergency water distribution points to collect a daily ration of just 6.6 gallons per person sometime before June or July. Now, largely thanks to radical conservation efforts - in January, the average Cape Town resident's daily water quota was just one-third the amount used by the typical Californian at the height of that state's 2016 drought - the city has reduced water consumption by 57 percent. Day Zero has been pushed back to July 9.

So, disaster averted? Nothing to see here anymore? Far from it. The city's efforts on the supply side of the water equation have been far less successful than its work on consumption. Even if the drought comes to an end in 2018 - and few experts are willing to predict that - the effects of this water crisis will be felt for years, possibly decades.

AN INDIAN CITY TOO ..!!!

Is Bangalore going to run out of water soon? The acute water crisis at Cape Town in South Africa has alarm bells ringing in Bangalore and the city even featured in a BBC list on 'The 11 cities most likely to run out of drinking water'.

With the city's planning in a shambles, experts say that Bangalore is definitely on its way to become the next Cape Town.

Although water shortage is definitely a problem, it may become a major crisis if the city's planners do not identify the core issues eating at Bangalore water management plan.

Successive governments have not bothered to look into sustainable avenues to manage the city's water requirements.

WHY A SINGLE SOURCE OF WATER IS NOT ENOUGH?

Despite the herculean effort to bring water to Bangalore all the way from the Krishna Raja Sagar Dam in Mandya district, the shocking reality is that only half of Bangalore gets Cauvery water - its according to data provided by the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board (BWSSB).

"It was only in 2017 that the Cauvery water pipeline work for the suburban areas of Bengaluru began. The heart of Bangalore gets Cauvery water. This is about 55% of the population while the rest who live in the suburbs mainly run on bore well water," a BWSSB official added.

ROLE OF STUDENTS IN DROUGHT MANAGEMENT:


