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
The Path of Success:

Bridge Course:

The Inauguration of Eruditica - The Literary Association was held on 25.06.2015. Ms. Anitha, Head & Assist Prof (SF), Nirmala College for Women, Coimbatore was the chief guest. Dr. Muralidara Kannan, Professor, Government Arts College, Coimbatore delivered a guest lecture on the topic, 'Life and Literature'. A Creativity Workshop was organized by the Association on 16.09.2015. Dr. P.R. Muthuswamy, Principal, Dr. N.G.P Arts and Science College was the Resource Person.



Drama Club:

The Drama club encourages the aspirants to think 'out of the box'. It provides the occasion to prove their acting expertise with good pronunciation skill and makes them develop team building and leadership qualities. Ms. Anitha, Head & Assist Prof, Nirmala College for Women, Coimbatore inaugurated the club on 25.06.2015. Induction Programme on Glimpses of the past, ABC of drama, Theatre Etiquette and Drama Activities- Group Tableau, Group Mime and Story Development was conducted on 14.07.2015. The club members have participated in Storytelling Workshop on 05.08.2015 organised by Dr Eric Miller- Founder and Director of the World Story Telling Institute, Chennai in Sapna Book House, Coimbatore. They participated in the State level intercollegiate competition at Sacred Heart College, Tirupattur on 15.08.2015. The Music Concert of the club provided the opportunity for the aspirants to showcase their music abilities on 22.09.2015. They won first prize in WINGS - an Inter-departmental competition on 29.09.2015 organised by Dept of English, Dr NGP ASC. They won first place in Mime event. On 01.10.2015 the club members participated in an Intercollegiate Competition conducted by Nirmala College for Women, Coimbatore and won the I Prizes in Drama, Hum a Poem and Soliloquy. On 09.10.2015 a Mini project presentation on Shakespeare was presented by III B.A English literature with CA students in Kambar Arangam. The club meeting was held on 09.01.2016 in Valluvar Arangam for the even semester. The objectives were discussed in it on the action plans for this semester like writing new scripts, performing on current issues and they were engaged with ice breaking sessions.

Sixty Sixty Club:



The English Department has inaugurated the activities of the 60/60 Club for the academic year 2015-2016 on 25th June, 2015 at 10 am held at Kambar Arangam. The Chief Guest of the day was Ms. Anitha Jose Paul, Assistant Professor of English, Nirmala College For Women, and Coimbatore for the Academic year 2015-2016. She delivered her speech entitled "Communicative English is the Key to Success"

The club conducted the orientation programme for the first year UG Students on 10.8.2015 on the importance and the need of improving their communication skills in the present scenario for the academic year 2015-2016 Odd semester. To highlight one of the events of the club, 5 students from the Tamil medium background delivered their speech on the Independence Day celebration (15.8.2015) based on the History of India's Independence, Freedom Fighters, Slogans and Quotations, the History and Do's and Don'ts of Indian National Flag. The club conducted the first activity JAM (Just-a-Minute) on 22.08.2015. On 12.9.2015 Story telling session was conducted and on 19.9.2015 Vocabulary activity was engaged. On 10.10.2015 Self-Introduction was executed.

In the Even semester of the academic year 2015-2016 the club conducted its activity on 23.12.2015 Students were involved in playing various Roles (Celebrities, Police, Lawyer, Teacher, and Politician. On 30.12.2015 Students were exposed to many speaking activities in improving their oratorical skills like Dialogue Conversation and Picture reading. On 06.01.2016 Students were trained on Public Speaking activities by involving them in various enthusiastic activities like Connect the Dots, and the BIG Fat Lie. On 13.01.2016 Students were implicated in Public Speaking activities like The History of..., and In the News Today. On 21.01.2016 Students were steered about the importance and the awareness of the signs and signals of body language and essential Body Language Tips were discussed. On 10.02.2016 Students were guided about the quintessential etiquette and manners of various types like Classroom etiquette, Student etiquette, Tele- etiquette, Table etiquette, and Club- etiquette etc.

On 17.02.2016 Guidelines and training on Spell Bee was practised in the session. The students were trained on basic spelling rules and its nuances to know better spellings for their spelling improvement. The students eagerly spelt the words with SAY-SPELL-SAY method and took more concern in correcting their minor errors in their spellings. On

24.02.2016 hands-on-training and guidance on Interview Skills was trained in the session. The session taught the students about the significance of Interview and its types and additionally taught how to prepare themselves physically, mentally and psychologically to face their Interview with much optimistic thought.

Youngistan Club:

Youngistan Club is the Readers' Club which interests the students more in reading habit. The club was incepted in the year 2010. The main objective of this club is to develop their critical view over reading and to provide with them opportunities to know the importance of reading. This club is designed for the all the UG students of all disciplines. Quiz Club:

Extension Activities :



Along with this the students were trained on the Key English Test modules of Cambridge Esol which has enabled them to become eligible to take up KET Exam Implementation of “Earn while you Learn” Scheme through Value Added Course

Potential students of the batch are selected under this scheme and they are provided chances to go and train various school children on their communication skills. And these trainers are remunerated for their projects. 13 potential students have totally received a sum of Rs.1,19,416 as remuneration through the value added programme.

Language Lab :

Language Lab enables the students to enhance their language skills. It is used in a productive manner to widen the knowledge of the students in all the specific areas of language. It is being effectively used by the Department of English. All first year students are engaged in language lab once a week. It imparts the students, Basic Grammar Modules as well train them the usage of language. The software CLARITY INFINITY is used from which some essential videos related to language are being telecasted to the students. Apart from all such activities a few more class room activities are conducted which includes Group Discussion, Extemporaneous Speech, Creative Writing, and Picture Talk.

BEC :

The Department offers two levels of Business English Certificate Course certified by the Cambridge University, United Kingdom through the Cambridge University Press at Chennai. This academic year there were a total of 105 students for BEC out of which 68 Students appeared for the Preliminary level and 37 students appeared for the vantage level.

Lit Spectra :

The Lit Spectra Magazine - volume four has been successfully released for the 4th consecutive year. It contains all the activities and achievements of staff and students of the department.
