Bridge Course is conducted every year to bridge the gap of the first year students in language and grammar competence from school to college. For this academic year the Bridge course was successfully conducted from 22.6.15 to 26.6.15. A separate course material was prepared by a vibrant team of faculty members for Bridge Course.

Eruditica - The Literary Association and all the clubs were inaugurated together on 11th July, 2016. Mrs. Shobana Rajkumari. S, Professor and Head, Department of English, Providence College for Women, Coonoor was the chief guest. The department has conducted 5 Guest Lectures in this academic year. The Various Clubs like the Drama Club, the Youngisthan Club, the 60/60 Club, Students Development Cell and the Literary Quiz club have conducted many activities for different audiences. Our students gave an excellent guest performance at the "The Book Fair" conducted in CODDISSIA in the month of August. Our students have won 189 prizes in various competitions at various levels.

Student Exchange Programme:

A Staff/Student Exchange Programme was organized between Providence College for Women, Coonoor and our College. 10 Students and one faculty member from each college were exchanged for a period of three days from 21.02.2017 to 23.02.2017. This programme paved the way for a different exposure towards different educational atmosphere.

A three day NET/SET orientation program was organized from 29.05.2017 to 31.05.2017. Dr. Kalyani Valath, Director, Total English Solutions was the resource person.

Drama Club:

The drama club was inaugurated for the academic year 2016-2017 by Mrs. Shobana RajKumari, Head, Department of English, Providence College for Women, Coonoor. The office bearers were elected. On 22.7.2016, the club conducted its first Induction Programme for the newly joined aspirants. Activities like image building, freeze

zone and improvisation were conducted. The basic theatre etiquettes were taught to the budding artists. On 3.8.2016,

the club aspirants participated in a State level intercollegiate meet held at Bharathiar University, CBE in Shakespeare 400-Literary Fest and won I and II consolation prizes in Drama and Mono-acting. On 16.8.16, the club conducted Stage Direction session. Ms Patricia Romila highlighted on the Structure of Drama and the elements in Drama. Events like Fluid Sculpt, Team Work and Stage Positions were taught to the students. On 15. 9.16, Mr. Rathnasami, Redt. HM gave a special Mono-Acting performance to the III B. A. English students. He enacted the Bedroom Chamber scene from Othello and the assassination scene from Julius Caesar.

On 11.9.16, the drama club aspirants along with the music club members participated in the 2nd State level intercollegiate meet ELLITES 2016, at Sacred Heart College, Vellore. The team won laurels in Compose and Sing, Poetry Enactment, Poetry Writing, JAM, JAM on Indian Writing in English and Quiz.



The drama club conducted a theatre workshop on Theatre Arts for Language & Personal Developmentat Don Bosco College, Yelagiri Hills on 13th and 14th February 2017. Nearly 250 students of Don Bosco College benefitted. The modules were a composition of Music Experience-Daffodils, Tableau- Russian Fairytale, Frame Swapping, Situational Talk, Picture Talk-Dr Faustus, Newspaper Enactment- Scripted Plays inculcating moral values, Participatory Theatre and Live Theatre.

On 28.2.17, the college's theatre team participated in Lit Zeal- Drama event in PSG College of Arts and Science (Unaided) and won the 1st prize. On 7.3.17, the team participated in Phoenix 2k17- Drama event in PSG College of Arts and Science (Aided) and won the 2ndprize.

As per the proposed plan, the drama club conducted its first certificate course on Language and Theatre for 60 students in the Even Semester. A total number of 30 hours



were allotted for this course from 5.12.17 to 6.4.17. The course was designed to enhance the communicative skills of the theatre aspirants. The course was designed with 8 modules like Frame Swapping, Playback Theatre, Soliloquy, Tableau, Action Haiku, Structured Play, Unscripted Play and News Lead. The activities of the drama club ended with the valedictory function on 7.4.2017.

Sixty Sixty Club:



The 60/60 Club was initiated in the academic year 2012-13. The main objective of this programme is to hone the students excellence in their LSRW skills and to improve their English Communication skills. Besides this club aims to inculcate among students a passion for English language and enhance their literary skills. This club is designed for the students of 60 boys and 60 girls exclusively from Tamil medium background. The mediocre students from all the UG first year are identified and selected as club members according to the testimony given by concern subject (General English) handling staff. The students are trained in various public speaking activities along with soft skills.

Language Lab

Language Lab enables the students to enhance their language skills. It is used in a productive manner to widen the knowledge of the students in all the specific areas of language. It is being effectively used by the Department of English. All first year students are engaged in language lab once a week. It imparts the students, Basic Grammar Modules as well to train them the usage of language. The software CLARITY INFINITY is used from which some essential videos related to language are being telecasted to the students. Apart from all such activities a few more class room activities are conducted which includes Group Discussion, Extemporary Speech, Creative Writing, and Picture Talk.

BEC

The Business English Certificate Course is offered by the University of Cambridge UK. The training for this course is provided by the Department of English to the students of all disciplines. The training programme commenced in the month of July 2016. The classes were conducted from the month of July 2016 to March 2017. Nearly one hundred and twenty students enrolled themselves for this course.







Three classes were conducted per week during the sixth hour. Students were trained with the help of various teaching aids like black and white board, audio visuals, books etc. and also they were made to take up many Mock Tests prior to the exam. The BEC Preliminary Exam was conducted on 8th and 9th March 2013, by the Cambridge University Press, Chennai. The number of students appeared for this exam was one hundred and twenty and the pass percentage was 97.5 %.

Students Development Cell

The students of the Students Development Cell have taken part in various Intra-department, Inter-department and Intercollegiate events and have won 2 overall championships and 189 prizes.
