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	<p>Scope and the procedure of the Equivalence Committee:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The committee will meet anytime for the transfer of courses / credits from our institution or other Higher education institution / Universities to an undergraduate and Post graduate applicant seeking readmission / lateral entry. 2. Upon successful completion of NPTEL Courses recommended by the department, a student shall be eligible to get exemption of course if the Equivalence committee verifies the course content and the regulation and approve the credit transfer. 3. A student who have not completed the degree during the duration of the programme as in the regulation, thereafter the student have to reappear the examinations of the arrear courses only on the current syllabuses in force for the regular students. If such current scheme / syllabus does not contain the course of the same title as the one in which he / she has to appear, he / she may be required to take the examination on an equivalent course as may be decided by the equivalence committee. 4. Not less than half of the total number of members of the committee shall constitute the Quorum for meeting of the committee.
