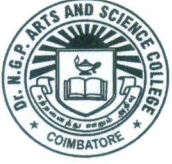

Guidelines & Instruction for Students

1. The exam timing is 01:00 pm to 03:00 pm. Exam will start and finish on time.
2. All the student should be seated in rooms allotted for exam by 12:50 pm.
3. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall for any reason during the test. Students are allowed to leave the hall only after 'OMR Sheet' from all the candidates have been collected and accounted for.
4. First 10 min from 12:50 pm to 01:00 pm should only be used for reading guideline and filling information on OMR sheet and question paper.
5. Calculator, electronic diary, cellular phone, pager and any such electronic gadget should not be allowed in the examination hall.
6. Student should only use HB pencil to mark his/her choices on OMR sheet. In case a student wish to change an answer, erase the old answer completely using a good soft eraser.
7. Student should use black ball point pen to fill side 1 of the OMR sheet.
8. Each correct answer carries one mark and a wrong answer carries negative 0.25 marks.
9. Student should give back the question paper and OMR sheet to the Hall invigilator.
10. The category in which the student count is less than ten for an institute/college, in that category student need to achieve minimum 90 percentile to qualify for 2nd round.
